Industry Updates

Update provided by Rob Selbie (RS), National Grid

- **European Network Codes Implementation:**

(RS) presented an overview of the EU network code implementation which included a stakeholder matrix, which can be used as guidance when assessing the impact of the EU network codes. Barbara Vest (BV) suggested generator category could be broken further by the size of the generator.
