1.0 SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

Executive Summary

1.1 CAP132-139 was raised by National Grid to address a number of minor housekeeping errors, such as spelling errors, incorrect referencing.

National Grid Recommendation

1.2 National Grid with the Amendment Panel's support recommends that CAP132-139 be approved for implementation 10 business days after an Authority Decision.

2.0 PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE REPORT

- 2.1 This Amendment Report has been prepared and issued by National Grid under the rules and procedures specified in the Connection and Use of System Code (CUSC) as designated by the Secretary of State.
- 2.2 Further to the submission of Housekeeping Amendment Proposal CAP132-139 (see Annex 1) and the subsequent wider industry consultation that was undertaken by National Grid, this document is addressed and furnished to the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") in order to assist them in their decision whether to implement Housekeeping Amendment Proposal CAP132-139.
- 2.3 CAP132-139 was proposed by National Grid and submitted to the CUSC Amendments Panel for consideration on the 29th September 2006 and the Amendment Panel determined that CAP132-139 was an appropriate Housekeeping Amendment in accordance with CUSC 8.21.2.
- 2.4 This Amendment Report has been prepared in accordance with the terms of the CUSC. An electronic copy can be found on the National Grid website, at http://www.nationalgrid.com/uk/indinfo/cusc.

3.0 THE PROPOSED HOUSEKEEPING AMENDMENT

Background

- 3.1 National Grid proposed CAP132-139 to address a number of minor errors within the CUSC falling within the definition of a Housekeeping Amendment.

8.0 VIEWS OF THE AMENDMENT PANEL AND NATIONAL GRID RECOMMENDATION

Views of the Amendment Panel

8.1 The Amendment Panel agreed that CAP132-139 was a Housekeeping Amendment that should be issued for 10 working days in accordance with CUSC 8.21.2.

National Grid's Recommendation

- 8.2 National Grid recommends CAP132-139 be implemented and will better facilitate CUSC Objective (a) by correcting minor errors with the CUSC therefore making it clearer and better fit for purpose.
- 8.3 In response to Centrica's clarification request, National Grid confirms that a week terminates at 05.00 hours.


