As you may already be aware the Western HVDC (High Voltage Direct Current) link has recently been out of service following a fault that developed during commissioning.

As of today, (Tuesday 16th October 2018) I am pleased to be able to advise that the Western Link Project released a news update to confirm that the link is ***“now available to operate, initially delivering up to 2250 MW power transfer capability from Scotland to England and Wales”***
