6.9.3 Modifications Proposed by The Company

- 6.9.3.1 If **The Company** wishes to make a **Modification** to the **GB Transmission System**, **The Company** shall complete and submit to each **User** a **Modification Notification** and shall advise each **User** of any works which **The Company** reasonably believes that **User** may have to carry out as a result.
- Any **User** which considers that it shall be required to make a **Modification** (an "**Affected User**") as a result of the **Modification** proposed by **The Company** (an "**Modification** Affected **User**") may as soon as practicable after receipt of the **Modification Notification** and (save where the **Authority** consents to a longer period) within the period stated therein (which shall be sufficient to enable the **User** to assess the implications of the proposed **Modification** and in any event shall not be less than 3 months) may make an application to the **Authority** under Standard Condition C9 of the **Transmission Licence**.

As soon as practicable after the receipt of the **Modification Notification** or, if an application to the **Authority** has been made, the determination by the **Authority**, and in any event within two months thereof, each **Modification Affected User** shall complete and submit a **Modification Application** to **The Company** and comply with the terms thereof. No fee shall be payable by any **User** to **The Company** in respect of any such **Modification Application**.
