Key areas of discussion

- CMP334 is essentially making the same changes that DCP359 is making to the DCUSA, to the CUSC and seeks to include definitions for “Single Site”, “Final Demand”, and “Final Demand Site”. Therefore, it was agreed to run CMP334 and DCP359 as a joint workgroup once the required 3 week workgroup nomination period had expired for CMP334.
- 2 workgroups (on 4 and 20 February 2020) were held for DCP359 had two workgroups prior to this workgroup on 4 and 20 February 2020, so the first part of the meeting was to ensure that everyone was updated on the work done so far.
- CMP334 has been decided as Urgent by the Authority, which means it can have shorter consultation periods than Workgroups under normal timescales. An indicative Urgent modification timeline was shared with the workgroup which shows a shorter Code Administrator Consultation period to allow CMP334 to be presented at the May CUSC Panel.
- The draft definitions from the DCP359 Workgroup were shared, as well as the CMP334 proposed definitions.
- The Workgroup created the consultation questions which will be used in both the DCUSA and CUSC workgroup consultations.

Next Steps

- Code Administrators (CUSC and DCUSA) will circulate a) updated legal text and b) draft Workgroup Consultations **by close of play 6 March;**
- Workgroup to send comments **by close of play 10 March;**
- Webex/Skype meeting **12-3pm on 11 March** to discuss any outstanding matters;

- **12 March and 13 March** will be used to finalise any drafting via circulation; and
- Workgroup consultation to be circulated **16 March**
