Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussed the following:

- In the workgroup consultation, it was highlighted that there were potential interactions with P396, a BSC modification. The workgroup discussed this further, and decided that further clarity was needed on where charges encompassed under other codes came under average charges for generation, as defined in the Limiting Regulation.
- The workgroup reviewed alternatives once again. The 21 potential alternatives which were decided upon in the previous workgroup were considered further, with standardised wording for the official raising of these alternatives collectively refined.
- The workgroup held an indicative vote on the alternatives, with all options receiving support to be made into WACMs. This vote will be formalised at the next meeting, pending discussions around P396 and BSUoS inclusion within average generation charges. This could lead to further alternatives being raised, dependent on the outcome.
