Key areas of discussion

- ESO's Original solution proposes to band new Transmission sites with no available consumption data based on an average annual consumption value of all Transmission connected Final Demand Sites. Noting that actual consumption data will become available for these sites as they start to consume demand, ESO feel it is appropriate to review the banding allocation outside of the start of a new price control for new transmission connected sites only.
 - The Workgroup met on 7 August to develop the 2 alternatives proposed by ESO in this area and agree the legal text for all solutions. The 2 alternative solutions, which were carried forward to the Workgroup Vote, were:
 - As per the CMP336 Original but introduce an annual September review to confirm the new transmission connection site is in the correct band and reallocate if required – this became CMP336 WACM1; and
 - Use a "User self-reported expected annual consumption figure", rather than the most recent 12 months average consumption of all transmission connected Final Demand Sites, for the purpose of banding - this became CMP336 WACM2.
- Workgroup reviewed the CMP335/6 legal text.
- Workgroup then met on 13 August to hold the Workgroup Vote:
 - On CMP335, the Workgroup concluded unanimously that the Original better facilitated the CUSC Objectives than the Baseline (the current CUSC arrangements); and

 On CMP336, the Workgroup concluded unanimously that the Original and WACM1 better facilitated the CUSC Objectives than the Baseline. Only 1 Workgroup Member thought that WACM2 better facilitated the CUSC Objectives than the Baseline.

Next Steps

- 14 August 2020 Code Admin to issue Workgroup Report to Workgroup for comment by 12pm on 18 August 2020;
- Meeting 19 August 2020 (if required) to discuss any showstopper comments;
- 20 August 2020 CMP335/6 Workgroup Report issued to CUSC Panel;
- 28 August 2020 CMP335/6 Workgroup Report will be presented to the August CUSC Panel – Panel will be asked to agree if the CMP335/6 Workgroup have met its Terms of Reference and this can proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. Further ahead, the CMP335/6 Draft Final Modification Report is expected to be presented to a Special Panel at the start of October 2020
