Background

- Issue arose out of CAP190
- Statutory Instrument (SI) 2005 No. 1646 "The Electricity and Gas Appeals (Designation and Exclusion) Order refers to a "majority recommendation"
- QC Advice highlighted an issue for the CUSC in that multiple recommendations in the Modification Report may cause ambiguity and could prevent an appeal
- CAP190 Workgroup approached DECC to investigate possibility of changing SI



Summary of Defect

- Ambiguity in interpretation of the SI with relation to the term 'recommendation'
- In CUSC Modification Report, reference to Panel, Company and Workgroup 'recommendations'.
- Could fetter right of appeal to Competition Commission



Proposed CUSC Modification

- Amend the CUSC to remove all references to 'recommendation' in the final CUSC Modification Report other than in reference to the Panel.
- The term 'recommendation' in relation to "The Company" and the "Workgroup" shall be replaced with similar meanings.
- Should have the effect of removing a potential barrier to the appeal rights

Justification against Applicable CUSC Objectives



- B) Facilitating effective competition
 - This Proposal will assist in facilitating competition in that it will remove a potential barrier to the right of appeal to the Competition Commission by having one clear Panel recommendation in the final Modification Report submitted to the Authority.

Code Administrator Proposed Progression

 - AGREE the establishment of a Workgroup to develop the proposal
 - AGREE the Workgroup Chair
