Current Position

- 30th December 2010 – CUSC Amendment Proposal
188 Implemented
- Section 14 of CUSC created
- Charging Methodologies now under CUSC
- No amendment to content at that stage
 - Charging methodology terms defined in Glossaries
 - Need to harmonise with section 11 definitions

Proposed CUSC Modification

- Consequential to CMP193 (Housekeeping modifications to Section 14 of the CUSC)
- Harmonises definitions previously contained in Charging Methodologies with CUSC definitions
 - 4 definitions amended
 - 3 new definitions added

Justification for Self-Governance

- Proposed changes are non-material
- Circulation of initial proposals for comment;
 - One comment regarding replacement of ‘GB transmission system’ with ‘National Electricity transmission system’

Applicable CUSC Objectives

- a) Efficient discharge of Act and Licence obligations
 - Fully incorporates Charging Methodologies' definitions within Section 11 of the CUSC.

- b) Facilitating effective competition
 - Improves clarity of Use of System and Connection Charging Methodologies within the CUSC and therefore better facilitates industry understanding, and hence competition.

Recommendation to the Panel

- The Panel is asked to agree that:
 - The proposal meets self-governance criteria
 - The proposal progresses straight to the Code Administrator Consultation
