
#### Introduction



- As part of the Code Governance Review Final Proposals, the Code Of Practice was established. This included a Principle for Code Administrators to report on KPIs
- The KPIs cover two measures:
  - Qualitative
  - Quantitative
- The KPIs are reported to the Panel each month, on a retrospective basis
- The KPIs identified in the COP are a minimum requirement and may be expanded

- Workgroup required

- CAP181– Consequential changes related to Grid Code Amendment A/10 (Compliance)
  - Date raised: 18th February 2010
  - Date Panel decision to proceed to Workgroup: 26<sup>th</sup> February 2010
  - Workgroup Consultation released 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2010 with a closing date of 7<sup>th</sup> July 2010, six responses were received
  - National Grid withdrew CAP181 in April 2011 as the defect is no longer applicable



- CAP189 Standard Gas Insulated Switchgear Ownership Boundaries
  - Date raised: 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2011
  - Date Panel decision to proceed to Workgroup: 30th July 2011
  - Workgroup consultation was issued on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2011 with a closing date of 8<sup>th</sup> April 2011
  - Workgroup Report to be presented at the 27<sup>th</sup> May CUSC Modifications Panel meeting



- CAP190 Two Thirds Majority Voting requirement for CUSC Panel recommendations on Amendments arising from Licence obligations Authority requests or obligations
  - Date raised: 26th August 2011
  - Date Panel decision to proceed to Workgroup: 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2011
  - CAP190 has been put on hold until July 2011 whilst CMP196 is progressed



- CMP191 NETSO Consultation in relation to any potential changes to the CUSC which takes place in forums other than the CUSC Modifications Panel
  - Date raised 14th February 2011
  - Date Panel decision to proceed to Workgroup: 25<sup>th</sup> February 2011
  - Workgroup consultation to be issued 6<sup>th</sup> June 2011



- CMP192 Arrangements for Enduring Generation User Commitment
  - Date raised 17<sup>th</sup> February 2011
  - Date Panel decision to proceed to Workgroup: 25th February 2011
