# Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure

## Overview

- We are in the process of developing a new cooperation mechanisms with EU stakeholders under the EU-UK Trade and cooperation agreement and technical procedures to coordinate with Europe.
- One of the TPs required is the Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Methodology.

## Activities Completed to date

Month	Activity
November/December	<p>The UK TSOs are continuing to develop their high level principles and develop a UK TSO position.</p> <p>It is foreseen that the EU TSOs will be returning for further discussions, negotiations and sharing their high level principles in January 2022.</p> <p>The UK TSOs will be meeting ahead of the Christmas break to discuss the preferred option for Day Ahead Capacity Calculation and consider how best to proceed with the high-level Technical Procedure document.</p>



# Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure

Month	Next Steps
January/February	<p data-bbox="828 315 2499 428">EU TSOs have advised that they will be meeting UK TSOs in January following their discussions with ACER/NRAs &amp; Commission.</p> <p data-bbox="828 471 2499 571">Aim to collectively draft a high level Technical Procedure which will be consulted upon in due course (date TBC).</p> <p data-bbox="828 614 2499 771">Following the above steps the aim is to submit the TP to the Regulatory Authorities for their opinion following which both the opinion and the TP will be submitted to the Specialised Committee on Energy.</p> <p data-bbox="828 813 2499 892">Plan to be shared once EU TSOs come back to the table to discuss.</p>
