




Wind Power Forecast

Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	<p>Today: Patchy drizzle and low cloud in southern UK clearing gradually, replaced by sunnier skies already in central areas; feeling milder. Blustery showers in parts of Scotland, wintry on hills, with early gales in the northeast; winds and showers easing later.</p> <p>Tonight: Many areas dry with clear spells, leading to a colder night. Frost will be fairly widespread in rural southern, central and eastern regions, with patchy fog in the south too</p>
