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What is the issue?

This modification is seeking to remove any gender specific references or terminology within the STC and make it Gender Neutral. A separate modification has also been raised in corelation to this for the STCPs'.1

Why change?

These changes will have a positive impact, as they will remove any gender bias, inequality, and discrimination within the STC. They will also acknowledge diversity and convey respect to all people. As well as aligning the STC to similar changes which have already taken place within the CUSC² and Grid Code³.

What is the solution?

The following changes will be required to the STC along with some other minor typographical amendments.

<u>Note</u> that following feedback on the CUSC modification CMP380 by the CUSC Panel on 26 November 2021. 'Chair' will be amended to 'Chairperson' to align the language with Standard Condition C14 1A(i) of the Transmission Licence.

- Amend the purple font in the numbering of 7.1.7 to black font.
- Amend the incorrect numbering of 7.1.10A to 7.1.11 and 7.1.12.
