

Headline Report – 31 August 2022

System Operator Transmission Owner Code (STC) Panel

The STC Panel Headline Report is produced after every Panel and aims to provide an overview of the key decisions made. Minutes for this meeting will be published separately.

Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 27 July 2022 had not been included with Papers so it could not be approved at the August 2022 Panel. These have now been re-circulated to Panel members for review and will be approved at the September 2022 Panel.

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

PM0120 (CMP328/CM078) “Connections Triggering Distribution Impact Assessment”

PM0120 seeks to make changes to System Operator Transmission Owner Code Procedures to reflect CUSC modification CMP328, relating to Transmission Connections that trigger Distribution Impact Assessment.

The Panel agreed to approve this STCP change ‘in principle’ with final approval to be made once the Authority reaches a positive decision on CMP328 and CM078. Panel members will be required to give a formal approval by circulation.

PM0127 (CMP286/287) “Improving TNUoS Predictability through Increased Notice of the Target Revenue & Inputs used in the TNUoS Tariff Setting Process”

PM0127 seeks to improve TNUoS predictability by increasing the notice of the Target Revenue and inputs used in the TNUoS Tariff Setting Process.

This modification was presented as a Draft modification to Panel and will be formally raised at the September 2022 Panel.

New / Pending Authority Decisions

Ofgem provided an update on Modifications that are awaiting their decision or have been decided upon since the last STC Panel on 31 August 2022.

Decisions since last STC Panel

There are no Ofgem decisions on STC Modifications since the last STC Panel.

Awaiting Decisions

The STC position is summarised below:

Modification	What this seeks to achieve	Expected Decision Date
CM078	Seeks to make changes to the System Operator Transmission Owner Code to reflect CUSC modification CMP328 relating to Transmission connections that trigger an impact assessment on the Distribution network.	30 November 2022, which is at the same time as the associated CUSC Modification (CMP328).

Workgroup Reports

There were no Workgroup Reports presented to the Panel.

Draft Final Modification Reports

The following Draft Final Modification Reports were presented to the Panel:

CM080 ‘Transmission Impact Assessment process in relation to CMP298’

CM080 seeks to include a process for aggregated assessment of Distributed Generators that impact (or may impact) on the National Electricity Transmission System.

Panel’s recommendation vote was postponed by the Chair to September 2022 Panel. This was because Panel was not quorate and some concerns were raised around the STCP changes. It was agreed that at the September Panel, the STCP modification will be presented before the recommendation vote is carried out.

CM083 – “Workgroup Quoracy Improvements”

CM083 seeks to update quoracy rules for modifications where there is limited STC Party impact
