



Near coasts, rain, sleet or hail and possible thunder. Many inland central and southeastern parts sunny but isolated freezing fog patches. Light winds for many. Cold. Tonight: Many inland areas clear and frosty, freezing fog becoming more of problem in parts of the south. Wintry showers near northern and western coasts, with ice and snow cover possible.
