



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Some sunny spells for most, although patchy freezing fog may prove stubborn. Wintry showers focused across coastal counties, including northeastern UK and southwest England this morning, perhaps reaching coasts of southeast England by dusk. Cold, especially where freezing fog lingers. Tonight: Coastal rain, with sleet and snow inland may affect parts of southeast England. Wintry showers affecting some coastal areas elsewhere but many inland parts frosty with some dense freezing fog.
