



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Wintry showers continuing across the far northeast. Scattered showers developing across Scotland and northern England. Cloudy with patchy rain for the far southwest and west but most parts dry with intermittent weak sunshine. Temperatures remain slightly below average.  Tonight: Cloudy in south Wales and southwest England. Patchy rain in Northern Ireland extending to Scotland with some hill snow possible later. Mostly dry elsewhere with clear intervals and isolated frost.
