# Approval of Panel Minutes

## **New Modifications**

The following new Modification Proposal was presented to the Panel:

# PM0129 'Compliance Processes and Modelling amendments following 9th August 2019 Power Disruption'

This proposal seeks to make changes to STC Procedure (STCP19-5) in order to achieve harmonisation with the Grid Code following modification GC0141 which was approved by the Authority on the 12 December 2022 to address concerns raised in the Ofgem and BEIS Report following the 9 August 2019 Power Disruption.

The Panel unanimously agreed that PM0129 should be implemented on the understanding that the Proposer will clarify specific concerns raised by OFTO representatives and address these outside the meeting and Panel Members will be informed of the outcome.

## New / Pending Authority Decisions

Ofgem provided an update on Modifications that have been decided upon and are currently awaiting their decision since the last STC Panel.

#### **Decisions since last STC Panel**

Modification	What this seeks to achieve	Decision
CM085	This modification seeks to clarify that where reactive capability is available it should be provided by OFTOs to ESO	Decision 31 March 2023 sending back CM085 for further work. April Panel agreed that a Workgroup needs to discuss Ofgem's reasons for send-back prior to this being re-presented for recommendation vote.

Modification	What this seeks to achieve	Expected Decision Date
CM078	This Modification seeks to make changes to the System Operator Transmission Owner Code to reflect CUSC modification CMP328 relating to Transmission connections that trigger an impact assessment on the Distribution network.	CM078 is dependent on CUSC Modification (CMP328) which was sent back to CUSC Panel by Ofgem on 14 February 2023. A decision will be made by Ofgem shortly after they have received the revised submission of CMP328.
CM080	Process for aggregated assessment of Distributed Generators that impact (or may impact) on the National Electricity Transmission System.	Expected decision date of this and related CUSC Modification (CMP298) is 29 May 2023
CM088	Fault Ride Through Definition	Final Modification Report sent to Ofgem 12 April 2023. Expected decision date is 9 June 2023
