Key areas of discussion

Workgroup Objectives

The Chair advised the Workgroup on the expectations and objectives for the meeting. The aim of Workgroup 4 was to review:

- Amendments to the legal text,
- Mapping tables,
- Draft Workgroup Report, and
- Agree that the Terms of Reference (ToR) had been met.

Amalgamation of modifications:

The Chair advised that the STC Panel had agreed to amalgamate the consequential changes arising out of the [GC0148](#) send back [CM091/PM0132](#), with the STC consequential changes [CM089/PM0128](#) for [GC0156](#). This will allow them to follow the same timeline and be sent off together to Ofgem for a decision.

Amendments to legal text:

The Proposer ran through the amendments to the legal text which included updates to the flow diagrams and very minor tweaks too the text. The Proposer also presented two mapping tables which showed how all the requirements within [GC0148](#) and [GC0156](#) will be mapped out into the STC and Grid Code.

Review Workgroup report:

The Chair ran through the amendments to the Workgroup report which largely included the incorporation of CM091 throughout the document. Workgroup members confirmed that they were not planning on raising any alternate solutions.

Review of Terms of Reference (ToR):

The Workgroup reviewed progress against the Terms of Reference and agreed that these had all been met.

Review of Timeline:

The Chair explained that to allow all Workgroup Members (who were not present) to also participate within the Workgroup vote this would now be deferred to the next Workgroup meeting. The Workgroup Report would also therefore be delayed and presented to the July STC Panel. But the Code Administrator Consultation would be reduced to 15 working days to allow the draft Final Modification Report to be still presented back to the August 2023 STC Panel.

The Chair summarised next steps as follows:

- Code Admin to re-circulate legal text, mapping tables and Workgroup Report.
- Code Admin to send out next Workgroup meeting invite - to hold Workgroup vote.
