



Strong winds will affect southern and southwestern parts in particular. Heavy rain and thundery showers will also cause some local disruption. Temperature below average. Tonight: Strong winds and heavy rain will gradually ease as Storm Antoni clears to the east this evening. Overnight, it will remain breezy with clear spells and a few showers.
