



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Outbreaks of rain will move northeast across England and Wales, giving some heavy and locally thundery downpours. Some brighter weather developing, especially later. Meanwhile Scotland and Northern Ireland will have a mix of sunny spells and scattered showers. Tonight: Lingering rain across northeast England will slowly clear, and showers will mainly become confined to northwestern areas overnight. Mostly dry elsewhere with clear spells and some mist or fog patches.
