



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Storm Betty brings rain and showers, heavy at times, across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Fine and dry for much of England and Wales, but scattered showers are possible. Windy, with gales in exposure, but feeling rather warm when sheltered. Tonight: Drizzly rain and showers affecting northwest Scotland and higher ground areas of western England and Wales. Largely dry elsewhere with clear spells. Warm night, but less muggy than those recently.
