



However, a few showers, mainly across northeast Scotland, northern and eastern England this morning. Rain and strong winds reaching Northern Ireland later. Tonight: Wet and windy weather in the far west, extending north and eastwards to many parts overnight. Turning showery in the north later. Mostly dry with clear spells in the southeast.
