



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: A rather cloudy and windy day for many with outbreaks of rain, turning heavy and persistent at times in the north and west, especially later. However, some early brightness in the north, and mostly fine across the southeast. Tonight: Wet and very windy weather in the north and west gradually clearing eastwards whilst easing overnight. Clear spells following for many, but with blustery showers in the north and northwest.
