



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Rain, some very heavy will continue to affect Scotland tomorrow, although it should brighten up across the far north. Elsewhere it will be generally dry with some very warm sunshine. Tonight: Outbreaks of rain affecting most of Scotland this evening and overnight, turning particularly heavy across central and western parts. Meanwhile, rain will die out across Northern Ireland, North Wales and northwest England. Otherwise, dry with clear spells and mist patches.
