



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Rain across northern Scotland slowly clearing eastwards during the afternoon. Elsewhere largely dry and after a murky start in places there will be plenty of spells of hazy sunshine. Tonight: Heavy rain across Scotland will gradually move northwards overnight, to lie across northern areas by morning. Elsewhere, dry and mild with often large amounts of cloud. Some mist and low cloud possible in far south and west.
