



A day of sunny spells and heavy thundery showers across the rest of the UK. Windy for all, with severe gales across Scotland. Tonight: Heavy rain will continue across northern and eastern parts of Scotland. Further heavy showers elsewhere. Then heavy rain arriving across southeast overnight, spreading to most areas by dawn. Staying windy.
