



Coastal gales along eastern Scotland gradually easing but persisting further north. Elsewhere, often cloudy with sporadic rain. Chance of heavy, thundery showers across South East England. Strong winds also along southern coasts. Tonight: Rain continuing across northern Scotland with coastal gales. Largely dry elsewhere with clear spells aside from a few coastal showers. Isolated mist and fog patches. Colder than
