## **DFS Eligibility Criteria Winter 23/24**

To participate in the DFS, Registered DFS Participants, and associated DFS Units (and their constituent Unit Meter Points), need to meet the below:

- 1. Half-hourly metering.
- 2. DFS units must be able to respond for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- 3. Be half-hourly settled for all meters (Profile Class 00), except providers participating on a domestic boundary meter (Profile Class 01 & 02) or where Industrial and Commercial Unit Meter Points are in Profile Classes 03 or 04.
- 4. Unit Meter Points cannot be allocated to more than one Registered DFS Participant.
- 5. Cannot form part of a BM Unit (except a Supplier Base BM Unit).
- 6. Cannot be providing any other ESO Balancing Service (including having a Capacity Market Agreement) or any similar service to any third party inclusive of DNO services.
- 7. 1 MW minimum DFS Unit size, up to 100 MW maximum DFS Unit size. Parties can register multiple units.
- 8. Be able to respond to an instruction for within-day and/or day-ahead delivery.
- 9. DFS Units can be aggregated on a national basis
