



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Blustery thundery showers will move eastwards across southern counties of England this morning. Central, southern and western parts of Scotland, along with northern England will have a cloudy day with showery rain. Otherwise there will be sunshine and scattered showers. Tonight: Most northern areas will be cloudy with rain at times. Some frost is possible under clearer spells across the far northeast. Elsewhere there will be clear spells and isolated showers.
