



Strong winds across southern England and Wales with coastal gales possible, but slowly easing through the day. Temperatures around average, but feeling cold in the wind. Tonight: Winds continuing to ease giving a mostly dry night with clear spells. Widespread frost forming with mist and fog patches too. Rain arriving into the far northwest.
