Headline Report – 27 June 2024

Grid Code Review Panel

The Headline Report is produced after every Panel and aims to provide an overview of the key decisions made. Minutes for this meeting will be published separately.

Approval of Panel Minutes

The minutes from the Panel meeting held on 30 May 2024 will be presented for approval at the Panel meeting on 25 July 2024.

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

GC0169: 'Material changes arising from Grid Code Modification GC0136'

This modification is designed to address a number of non-specialist changes identified following Grid Code Modification <u>GC0136</u>: <u>Non-material changes to Grid Code following implementation of the EU Connection</u> <u>Codes</u>.

GC0173: 'Consistency of Technical and Compliance Requirements between GB and European Users'

This modification is designed to ensure alignment between the Grid Code Connection Conditions and European Connection Conditions and interactions with the Compliance Processes and European Compliance Processes in addition to a data clarification in the Planning Code in respect of thermal storage technologies.

GC0169 was re-presented to the Panel after being split into two separate modifications GC0169 and GC0173. The Panel unanimously agreed that both GC0169 and GC0173 should follow the Standard Governance route and proceed to a single joint Grid Code/Distribution Code Workgroup. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for GC0169 and GC0173.

<u>GC0174: 'Removal of obligation to provide EU Transparency Availability Data as specified in</u> <u>OC2.4.7'</u>

Following the approval of BSC Modification CP1583 (Rationalising publication of European Transparency Regulation data on Elexon Systems), the obligation for parties to submit EU Transparency Availability Data as specified in OC2.4.7 is no longer required.

The Panel concluded that in order to determine the Governance route further clarity needed to be added into the Proposal. The Panel requested that the Proposer of GC0174 return to the July 2024 Grid Code Review Panel.
