



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Largely dry across southern and central areas with spells of hazy sunshine. Elsewhere, rain spreading into Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of north Wales and northwest England, becoming heavy and persistent over hills. Windy in the north, with coastal gales. Tonight: Further rain across the north, again heavy and persistent over hills. Drier towards the south, but rain reaching southwest England and south Wales later. Windy in the north and west.
