



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Heavy rain moves across the south through the morning, clearing the southeast by the afternoon. Sunshine and heavy showers follow, with winds increasing in the north to begin with but turning drier in the southwest later. Feeling cooler. Tonight: Daytime showers becoming confined to the far north and west. Turning drier with clear spells elsewhere. Wind easing overnight and feeling cooler than previous nights.
