



However, a band of rain gradually moving south across England and Wales. Sunshine and blustery showers further north. Heavy rain and gale force winds affecting the far northeast of Scotland. Turning colder.  Tonight: Rain soon clearing from southeast England, then a colder night than of late everywhere. Clear periods, but with blustery showers in the north and west. Patchy frost in the north.
