

## Fast Reserve

### Market Information for Tenders for March 2014

National Grid publishes this information, in order to inform potential participants for the Fast Reserve tender round for March 2014.

### Fast Reserve Availability

Our indicative requirement for Fast Reserve in March 2014 is shown on a Settlement Period basis in Figure 1. This requirement covers weekdays, Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

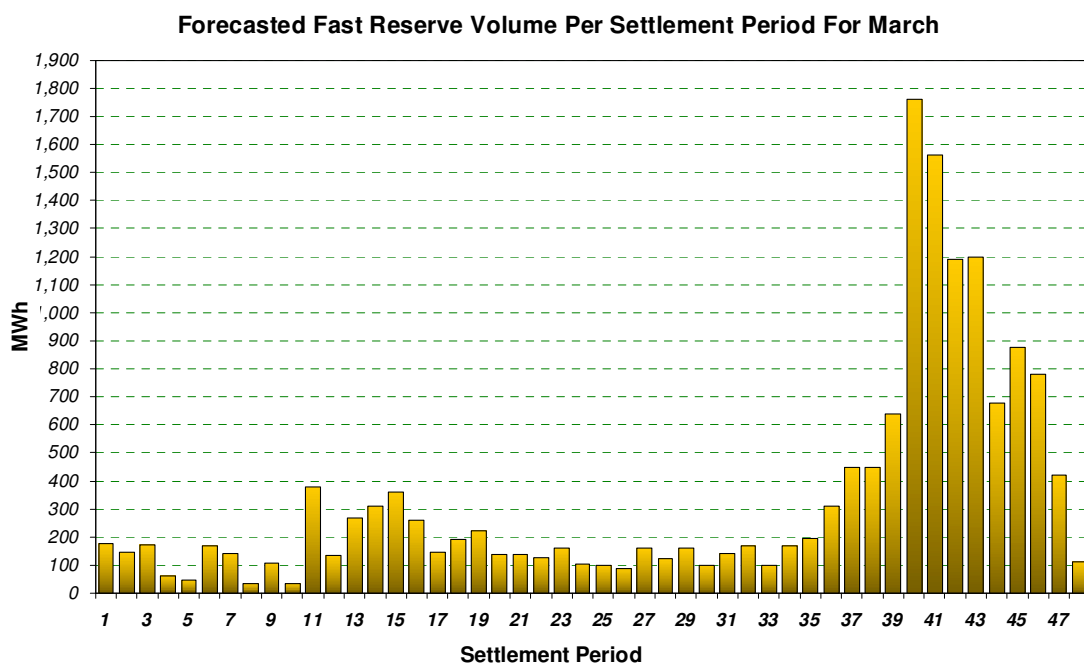

Figure 1 gives an indication of the times of day when Fast Reserve is most useful to National Grid. The actual amount of Fast Reserve "holding" varies from day to day, according to system conditions. In general, it might be good to have around 300 to 400MW of fast reserve service contracted during daytime period.

### Fast Reserve Utilisation

The following BM information is based on the aggregate of Offers plus Bids accepted to provide Fast Reserve or an equivalent service. Note that the data for January 2014 contains both out-turn and forecast.

Figure 2 shows the daily utilisation of Fast Reserve in the BM and elsewhere during December 2013 and January 2014.

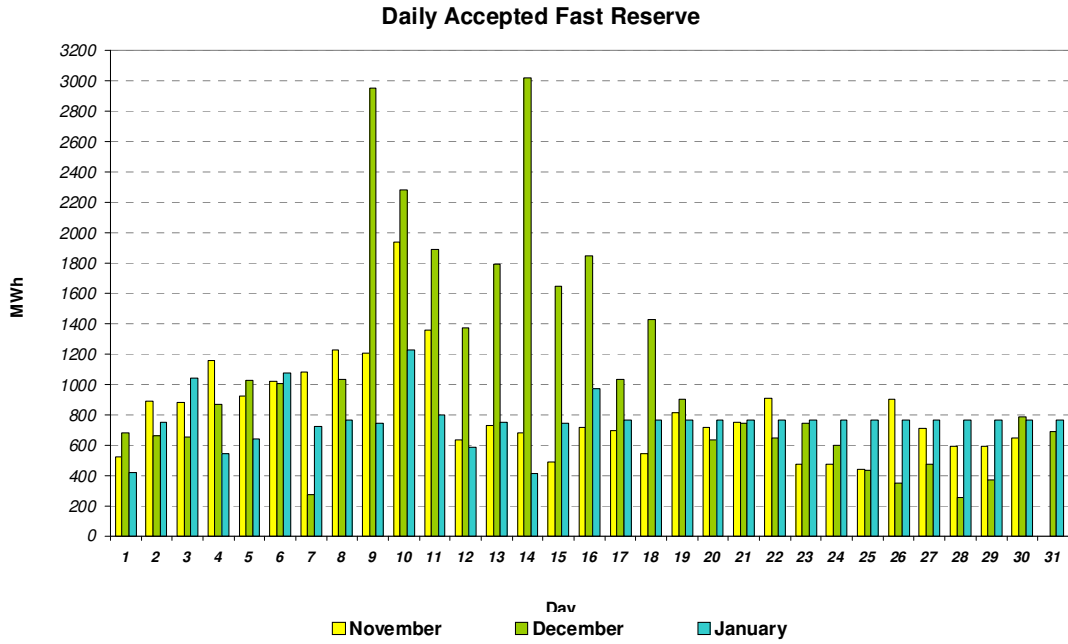

Figure 3 represents this data as total utilisation by Settlement Period across each month. This shows the daily profile of Fast Reserve utilisation.

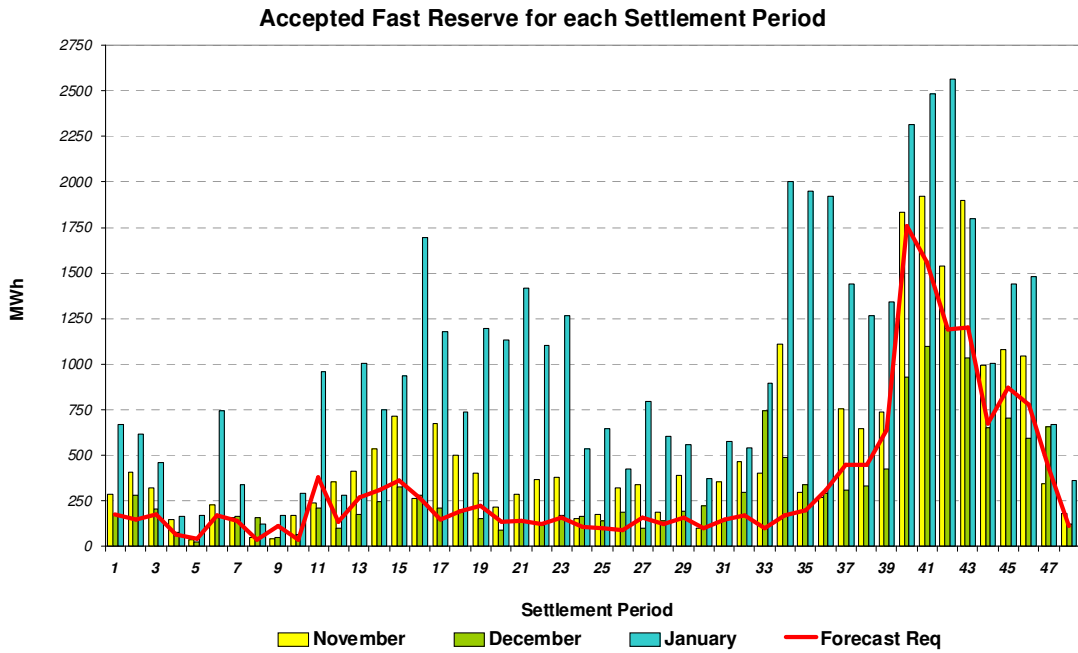

Figure 4 represents the same historical data, as an average utilisation price per Settlement Period for each month.

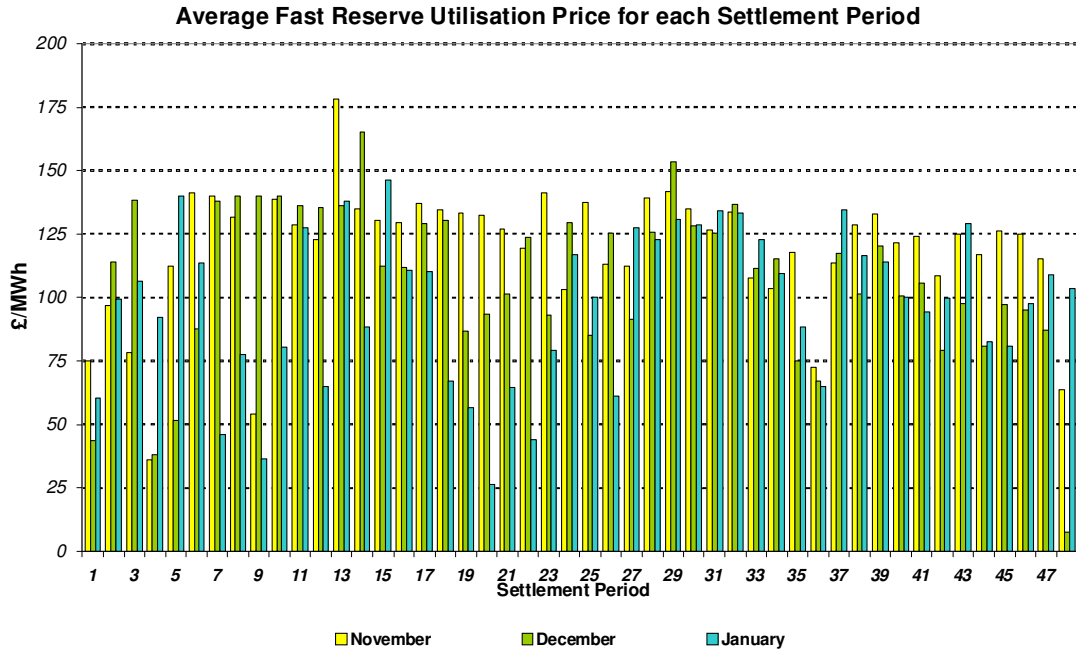

Finally, the same data is used in Figure 5, below, to show the profile of total Fast Reserve utilisation expenditure per Settlement Period for each month.

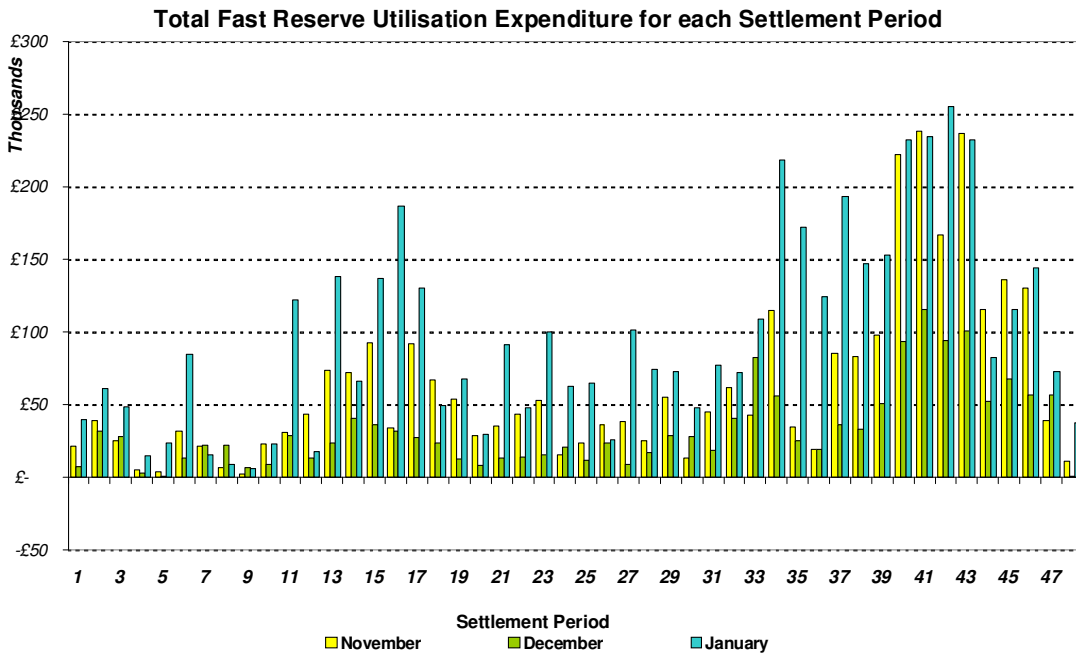
